Game Day Regulations

- ✓ All players should sign the waiver located on your dashboard through our website.
- ✓ All registration fees must be paid in full by Thursday May 12th at 10:00 am.
- ✓ The tournament is rain or shine. We will play in rain and mildly inclement weather, in accordance with PSL's Weather Policy. If a storm would occur, we would (1). Go on a Rain Delay. (2). If the rain delay exceeds one hour, we will reschedule the tournament. In this event, PSL staff will communicate with you any expectations and next steps.
- ✓ You can follow scores and standings throughout the day on your phone through your PSL Dashboard for the tournament.
- ✓ Please be mindful that you are in a public park with a pool, playground and dog park within the vicinity. Please act courteous to all people in the area and represent the PSL and PUMP with respect to other recreationalists using the park. This is a congested area and we should be on our best behavior at all times.
- ✓ You are not allowed to drive or park within the trails/emergency roads within the park. You will be ticketed by the Police if you attempt this.
- ✓ You are welcome to bring tents, food, drinks and games.
- ✓ Championship prizes of gift cards to our Hometown Hot Spots will be given immediately following the games.
- ✓ Please make sure to stay on time, show good sportsmanship and always clean up after yourself! There will be garbage and recycling available.
- ✓ Please remember to bring your own water, water bottle, and sunscreen. We will not provide cups at the tournament.
- ✓ We will not have trainers present, but we will have a first aid kit and ice packs for injuries at the PUMP table.



Tournament Structure & Schedule

Games will be played 4 x 4 (1 gender minority minimum), with a roster maximum of 8 players. As per our Inclusivity Statement, players should register and play in the way that most closely aligns with their gender identity.

POOL PLAY: Each team plays 2 games to 17 points against the other 3 teams in their division (3 games).
